Non-Academic Artifact Guidelines

General Info:

Only **one** per year. Student works or achievements demonstrated or produced outside of the classroom setting.

Examples: 4-H Boy/Girl Scout awards/ribbons.

FFA Awards or participation.

Newspaper clippings of your achievements.

Student Council or club participations. Church/Religious projects or participation.

Individual or group community service projects.

Other personal achievements.

The Paragraph:

1. Identify the purpose of the artifact.

2. Point out the parts of the artifact which especially reflects quality.

3. Explain how this artifact fits into the whole portfolio.

4. Must be typed, on white paper, with no errors, in complete sentences. Be sure to include your name, grade, and date on the top of the artifact.

Example:
