- Each day participants will join in leadership activities, educational conservation and ecology opportunities, and hands-on service learning. Youth will be engaged in important conservation and park projects while working as a team, gaining self-esteem, and learning social responsibility and respect for the environment.
- <u>Crew members will be provided work gloves, water and snacks, and a crew member t-shirt.</u>
 Members should dress to get dirty and be prepared to do physical hands-on conservation work. Equipment needed for projects will be provided onsite.
- Projects may include invasive species removal, trail maintenance and brush clearing, bird house monitoring and maintenance, park clean-up, species surveying and monitoring, assisting with the creation of short informational videos, and native plantings and demonstration garden care.
- Youth participating will gain skills to last a lifetime, friendships, natural resource knowledge
 and abilities, and a stronger connection to the environment. Hours of service may also be
 used for community service hours at local schools and listed on a resume.
